**From the desk of John McSorley**

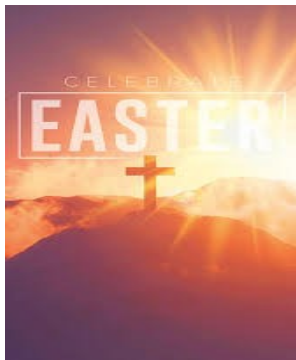
Our Mass in our Chapel is on Wednesday, April 8, at 1:30. Father Joe will preside. The rosary will be said prior to Mass starting at 1:00.
