

## **Ann's Choice Bible Study: John Chapter 8, January 20, 2021**

Read John 8:1-11

1. When Jesus again began to teach in the temple courts, the Jewish leaders had a plan to trap him. Who did they bring to Jesus and what was their question for him? How was this a trick question?

2. What did Jesus do before he answered them?

3. What was Jesus' answer to the Jewish leaders? And what was the result?

See Romans 3:23

4. What did Jesus do with the woman presented to him? How do you think she felt?

Read John 8:12-20

5. How does Jesus describe himself in this passage and what is the benefit to us?

6. How did the Pharisees react?

7. Jesus told the Pharisees that their judgment was different from his. Explain the authority of his judgment.

8. Still, no one seized Jesus. Why is that?

Read John 8:21-30

9. Jesus pointed out more differences between himself and the ones questioning him. Tell us a few of the differences.
  
10. Jesus seemed to foretell his sacrifice for our sins, but they did not grasp what he was saying. Cite the verse where he tells them about the cross.

Read John 8:31-47

11. Many Jews began to believe Jesus at this point in his teaching, and the number of disciples grew. What did Jesus say would be the result of belief in his teachings?
  
12. Why were the Pharisees offended? What was the error in their logic?
  
13. What did Jesus say was the result of being a child of God?

Read John 8:48-58?

14. Who was Jesus seeking to glorify? Who was responsible for glorifying Jesus?
  
15. What is the result of belief in Jesus?
  
16. How does Jesus tell of his being with God in the beginning and being one with God?
