Back in 2010, Bob Klimek, a resident of Maple Terrace, saw the need for a resident website dedicated specifically to the interests and needs of the residents of Ann’s Choice. On his own, Klimek devoted four months of his time to gather the information needed and then designed the website to be easy to use and to provide the information in a clear, concise manner.



In early 2011 the website was introduced to the Ann’s Choice residents for their use. Included were things like a complete list of all clubs and activities. Up until that time this information was not available anywhere to the Ann’s Choice residents. Klimek added this and then that and more, etc.

Klimek then recruited nine interested fellow residents to help grow and maintain the information in the website. Klimek’s business background taught him that nothing is worse than a website with inaccurate or outdated information.

Never unsubscribe from spam emails. We're talking about a random illicit message sending you malware links. Clicking the "unsubscribe" link might seem like a good idea, but it could make your situation worse. Spammers blast out millions of such messages, and a click from you is a ping from out of the void that marks you as a live one and now you'll be more specifically targeted.
