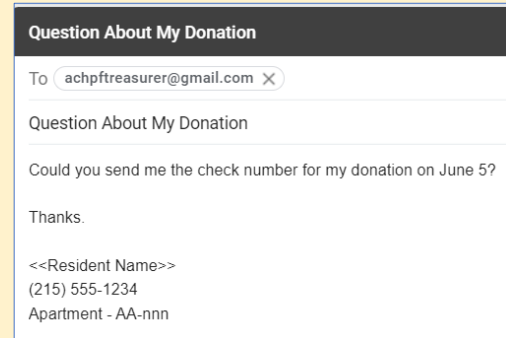

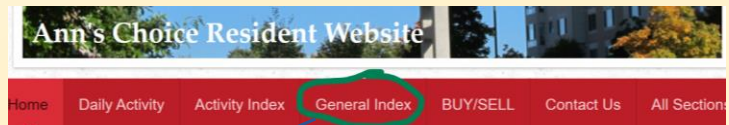

## Protestant Fellowship Announcements April 21, 2024

### • **Spotlight on Mission – National Giving Alliance**

- Originally named Needlework Guild of America, NGA was founded in 1885 in Philadelphia. The women who founded it were inspired by Lady Wolverton's Queen Mary's London Needlework Guild.
- The Needlework Guild of America in its first year made 921 garments to distribute to children in hospitals, orphanages, and to individuals and families who were needy. They made each child two articles of clothing: one to wash and one to wear.

### • **Spotlight on Mission – National Giving Alliance**

- Other agencies focus just on the clothing issue. NGA seeks to deal with the underlying issues in the lives children where clothing challenges are symptoms.
  - Feeling excluded, invisible, or rejected
  - Bullying and chronic absenteeism
  - Significant drop-out risk
  - Hygiene-related health issues
  - Lack of protection from bad weather

### • **Spotlight on Mission – National Giving Alliance**

- NGA collaborates with school districts and community organizations to reach youth in need.
- Through donations and partnerships, NGA procures quality new clothing from manufacturers and retailers at low- or no-cost.
- Kids receive specific clothing (often more than a week's worth) matched to their individual needs.

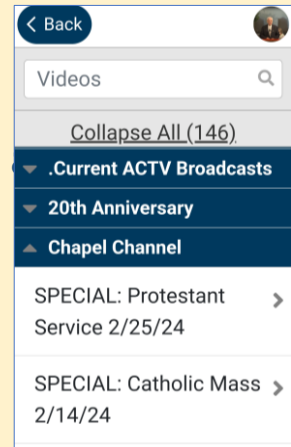

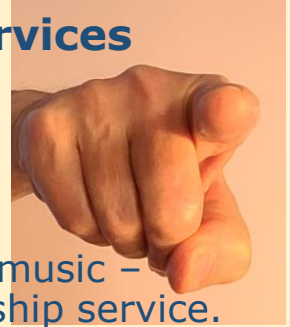
