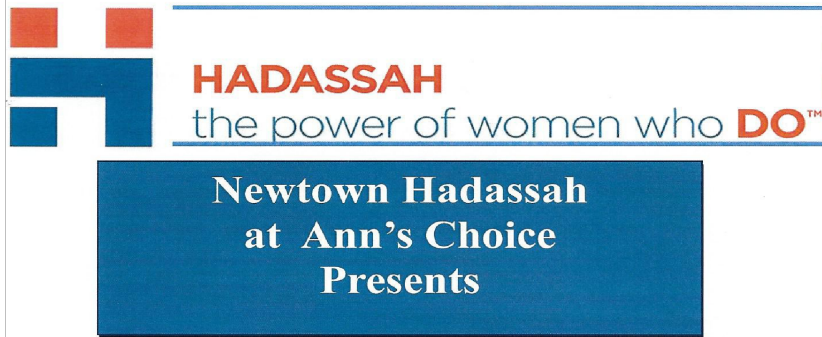

a Late-Life Second
Career Rabbi*

*How she came to discover her Jewish heritage in her 30s,
her return to Jewish life and practice, and what it is like to
take the leap to become a second-career rabbi later in life.*



Anne Pettit was a member of Congregation Brothers of Israel for six years before being tapped to serve as Rabbinic Intern at CBOI. She has extensive Jewish education, including a year at the Jewish Theological Seminary and five years at the Drisha Institute in New York City, a center of educational excellence that offers learning programs focused on classical Jewish texts and works to advance women's learning at the highest level. She also holds a Juris Doctor degree from Fordham University School of Law and is a retired attorney. Currently, she is enrolled in Rabbinical Seminary International's program of rabbinic studies, and expects to be ordained in June 2025.
