

Rabbinic Intern Anne Pettit Leap of Faith: Becoming a Late-Life Second Career Rabbi

How she came to discover her Jewish heritage in her 30s, her return to Jewish life and practice, and what it is like to take the leap to become a second-career rabbi later in life.



Anne Pettit was a member of Congregation Brothers of Israel for six years before being tapped to serve as Rabbinic Intern at CBOI. She has extensive Jewish education, including a year at the Jewish Theological Seminary and five years at the Drisha Institute in New York City, a center of educational excellence that offers learning programs focused on classical Jewish texts and works to advance women's learning at the highest level. She also holds a Juris Doctor degree from Fordham University School of Law and is a retired attorney. Currently, she is enrolled in Rabbinical Seminary International's program of rabbinic studies, and expects to be ordained in June 2025.
