



- Reminder Hearing Loop System in Chapel
  - · A couple of years ago when new carpeting was installed in the chapel, a hearing loop system was installed.
  - •A T-coil, or telecoil, is a small copper coil in a hearing aid that functions as a wireless antenna that links to the "hearing loop" system.
  - It results in significantly improved listening by making speech much clearer.
  - It is an option on most hearing aids.


