If you want to be included in our Passover wishes to the entire Jewish Resident Council, get you \$5 to Mimi by March 11 (date has been extended).



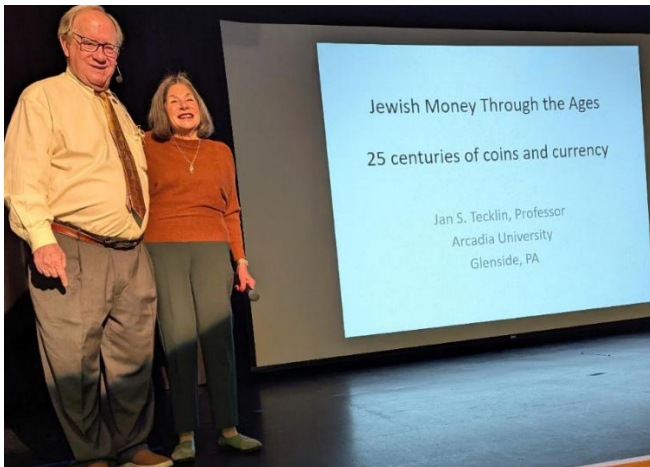
