**Rethinking Our Practices About Climate Change
to be More Consistent with Jewish Values and
For Greater Impact.**

Following a brief overview of climate change, we will discuss why Jews should work to avert the climate crisis, the existential threat impacting us and future generations. We will talk about concrete and practical sustainable changes we can make as individuals, and collectively. Then we will discuss why systemic problems demand systemic solutions. Rather than only focusing on individual behaviors we need to advocate for systemic and structural changes that are required for addressing climate change. We need to engage in the three pillars of climate action: leveraging for corporate responsibility, leveraging for public policy and personal responsibility. Personal responsibility is essential to have credibility when interacting with decision-makers in corporations and governments.



After a successful academic career, Phyllis now devotes full time to advocating for reducing the effects of the climate crisis. She is active in many environmental organizations that are promoting environmental sustainability at the local, state, and national levels, and especially with the Jewish Earth Alliance where she is the co- chair of their Steering Committee and the national chair for their twice-yearly successful lobby days. She won local and PA awards for her efforts from the League of Conservation Voters of PA.

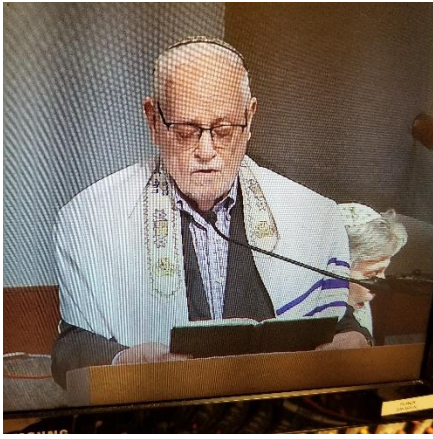
