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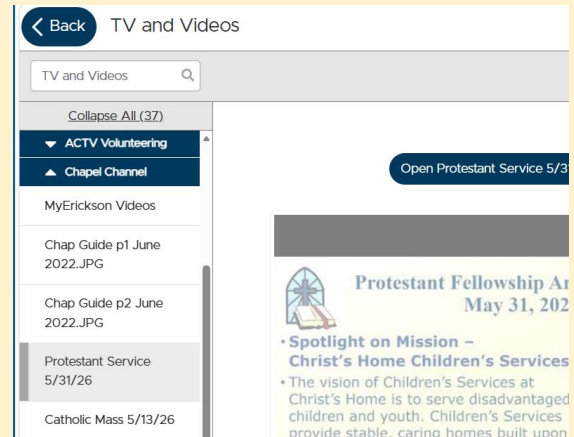

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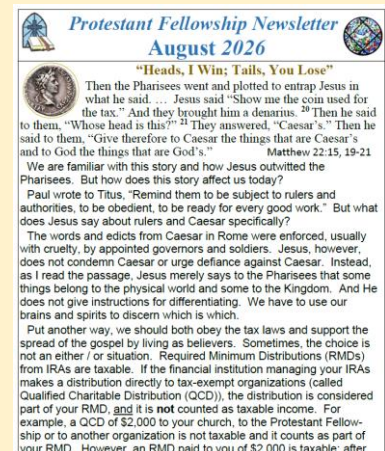

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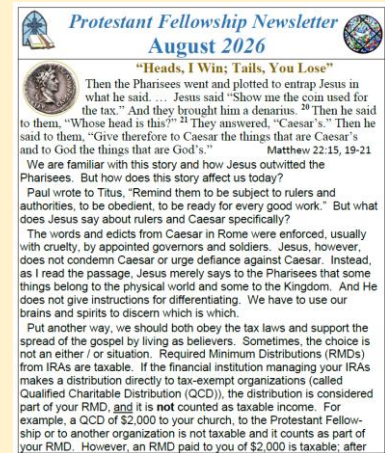

- A free-will offering will be received at the conclusion of the program with all the proceeds going to the Benevolent Care Fund.

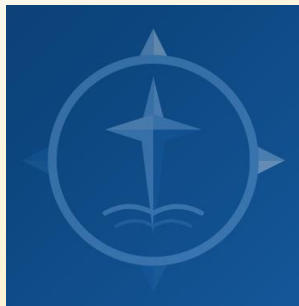

- Rev. Steve Cushing will discuss the work of the mission as it serves sailors and

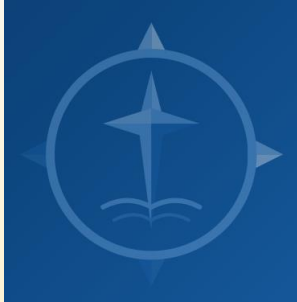
mariners who dock in Boston, Providence, and Narragansett Bay as well as how the mission started and whom it serves.

- Port chaplains visit ships daily, offering spiritual care, a listening ear, and practical help to crews far from home.

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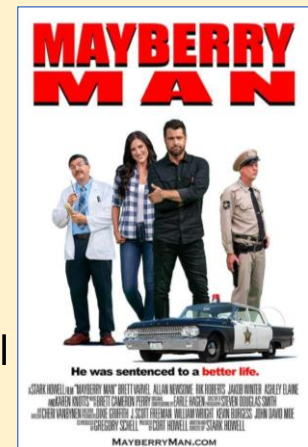

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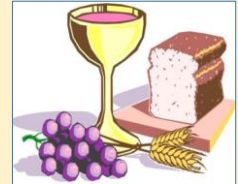

• **Reminder – Hearing Loop System in Chapel**

- A couple of years ago when new carpeting was installed in the chapel, a hearing loop system was installed.
- A T-coil, or telecoil, is a small copper coil in a hearing aid that functions as a wireless antenna that links to the “hearing loop” system.
- It results in significantly improved listening by making speech much clearer.
- It is an option on most hearing aids.

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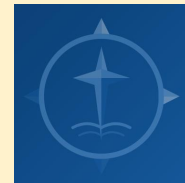

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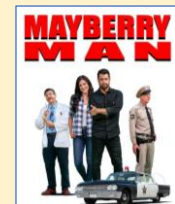
