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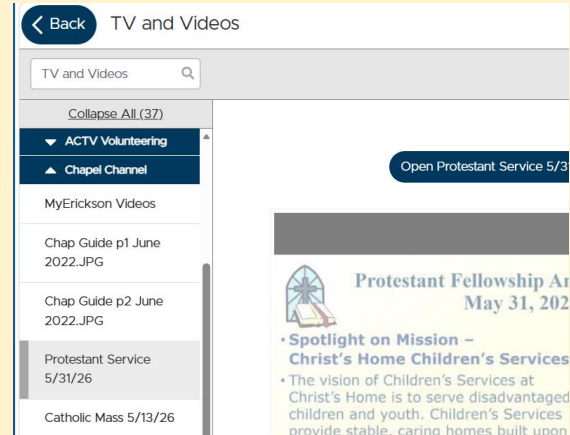

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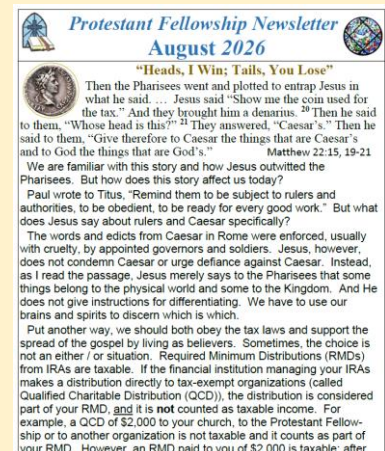

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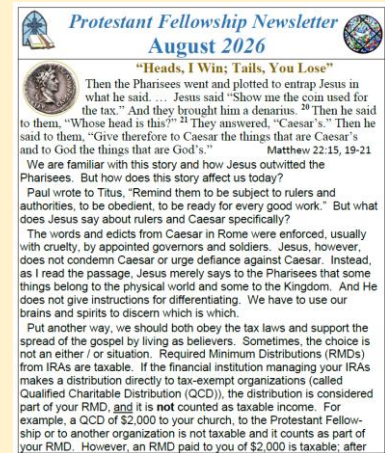

- Three American women working in Rome, Italy share a spacious apartment and the desire to find love and marriage. Each one experiences a few bumps in her journey to romance.

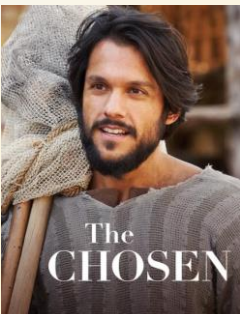

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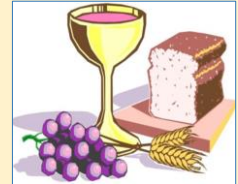

### • **Reminder – Hearing Loop System in Chapel**

- A couple of years ago when new carpeting was installed in the chapel, a hearing loop system was installed.
- A T-coil, or telecoil, is a small copper coil in a hearing aid that functions as a wireless antenna that links to the broadcast from the “hearing loop” system.
- It results in significantly improved listening by making speech much clearer.
- It is an option on most hearing aids.
